To better reflect our commitment to the entire Muncie area and signal our mission to provide trusted financial partnership to everyone, we embraced a new identity: PrimeTrust Financial Federal Credit Union. For ninety years, through changing times and economic cycles, our core mission has remained the same: to be a reliable, member-focused financial institution dedicated to the well-being of the Muncie area and its residents.
